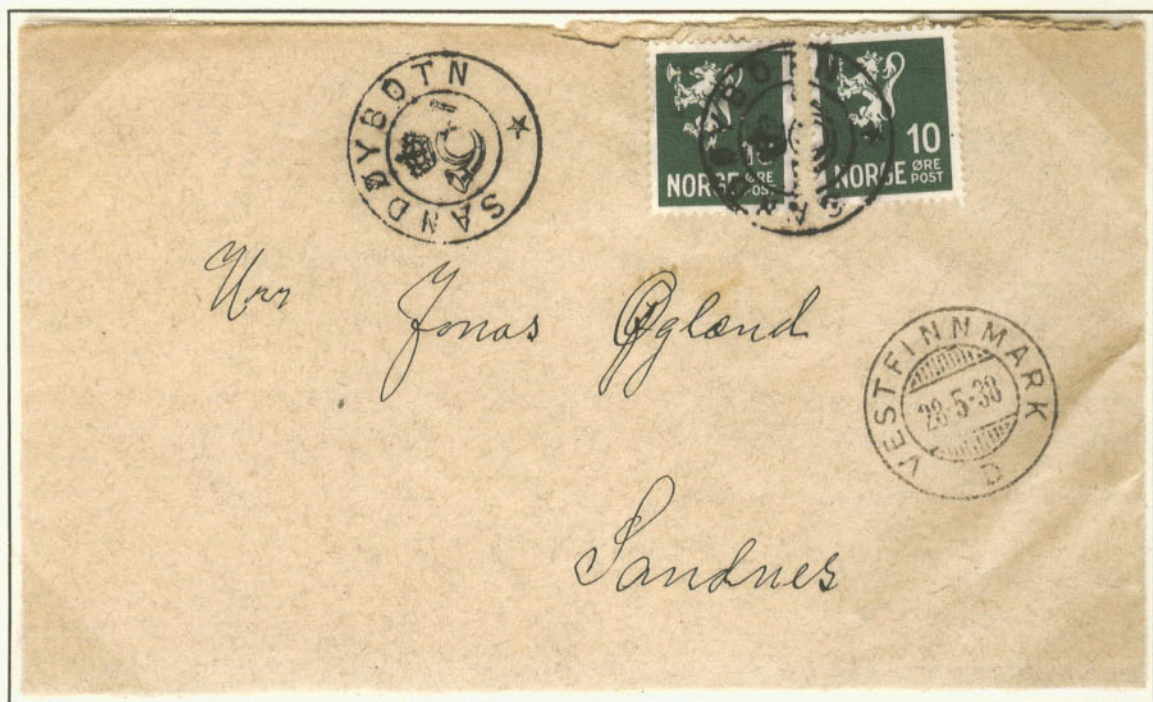
#### Outer coastal routes

##### Vestfinmarks postekspedition (1921-1944):

"Vestfinmarkens postekspedition" changed name to "Vestfinmarks postekspedition" in 1921. New cancellers with text "VESTFINNMARK A" (type 4 A) and "VESTFINNMARK B" (type 4 B) were delivered in 1926; "VESTFINMARK C" (type 4 C) and "VESTFINNMARK D" (type 4 D) in 1932



Post card (20 øre franking), from Børfjord in Finnmark to U.S.A., with crowned posthorn postmark "BØRFJORD" (class 4 post office), re-transmitted on board S/S Brynilen in Finnmark Fylkesrederi's (FFR) route 5 B (Galten route) and postmarked "VESTFINNMARK B 5-12-35" (type 4 B)



Domestic single-weight letter (20 øre) from Sandøybotn in Finnmark to Sandnes in South Norway; cancelled with crowned posthorn postmark "SANDØYBOTN" (class 4 post office), re-transmitted on board S/S Renøy in FFRs route 5A to Sørøya and postmarked "VESTFINNMARK D 28-5-38" (type 4 D)
