

XIII. The regional ship mail services

Tourist route Trondheim - Nordcap 1883 - 1916

In June 1883, Det Bergenske (BDS) og Det Nordenfjeldske Dampskibsselskab (NFDS) started a tourist route from Trondheim to Nordcap sailing in the summer months. Altogether 9 different ships sailed in this route, among others NFDS' S/S Sverre Sigurdsson and S/S Olaf Kyrre



10 øre postcard (stationery) with private circular ship postmark "SVERRE SIGURDSSON NORDCAP 25 JULI 86" in violet used in the tourist route from Trondheim to Nordcap, posted on retour in Hammerfest and date-stamped "HAMMERFEST 26-7-86"; sent to Germany with receiving postmark "METZINGEN" on August 2, 1886



Private envelope inscribed "Det Nordenfjeldske Dampskibsselskab. Trondhjem. TOURIST ROUTE TRONDHJEM - NORDCAP "S.S. OLAF KYRRE", franked with NK 54 IV, cancelled "HAMMERFEST" on July 24, 1892, on a north-bound trip to Nordcap; addressed to North Dakota, United States of America, stamped on arrival (reverse)
