

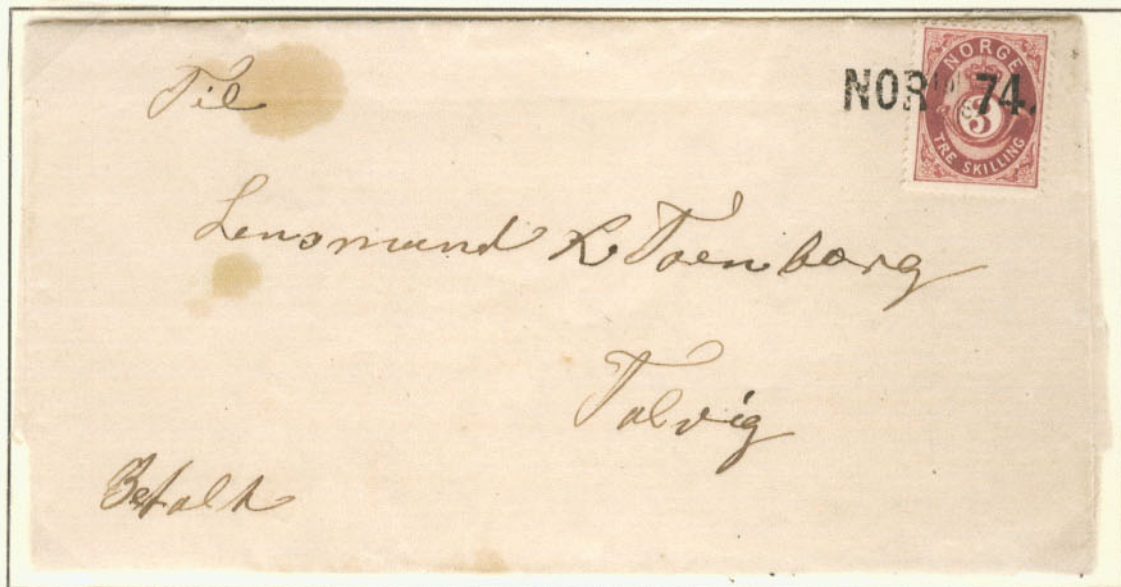
#### XIV. The local ship mail services

Route on Altenfjord

S/S Nor (1870-1882):

Type 3 (1874):

A type 3 handstamp in black stroke is recorded from June 27th until September 6th 1874



Single-weight local letter of August 19, 1874; from Korsnes in Altenfjord (inside) to Talvig, franked with 3 Sk post horn with origin ship postmark "NOR" (type 3). The cover lacks additional markings as it has not passed any exchange post offices on its way to Talvig  
**Only two letters with the NOR type 3 cancellation are registered**

Pen manuscript markings (1875-1882):

In a period from 1875 to 1882, the captain or a postal clerksman cancelled the mail with the ship's name in pen manuscript



Single-weight local letter of March 3, 1875; from Riverbugt in Altenfjord (inside) to Talvig, inscribed "Magtpaaliggende" (urgent) on front, delivered on board the steamer "Nor"; 3 Sk postage stamp is pen-crossed and cover with postal manuscript "Nor 8-3-1875". According to the written content, the letter enclosed 2 Spd in bank notes, which was an illegal procedure. An extra charge was to be collected for the registration of a money letter. The postal rate for a money letter carrying < 25 Spd. was 6 Sk, included a registration fee of 3 Sk [postage rate from 1-1-1872 to 1-1-1877]  
**Only registered letter with this type of postal manuscript in the period**
